

WESTCOTT

SUNDAY 4 AUGUST

Prudential RideLondon is the world's greatest festival of cycling with more than 100,000 cyclists participating in seven events on traffic-free roads in London and Surrey. Events will take place in central London on Saturday 3 August and in London and Surrey on Sunday 4 August 2019.

Prudential RideLondon was developed by the Mayor of London, Transport for London and London & Partners in partnership with Surrey County Council and is sponsored by Prudential. The event is managed by the London & Surrey Cycling Partnership.

EVENTS IN SURREY

Sunday 4 August

- Prudential RideLondon-Surrey 100, a mass participation ride for 25,000 cyclists; passing locally along the A25 from 08:05 until 13:55.
- Prudential RideLondon-Surrey Classic, a race for 150 professional cyclists; passing through Westcott once at 15:15.

All event timings are predicted and may vary slightly.

LOCAL ROAD CLOSURES

Roads closed from 05:00:

A25 from Newlands Corner to Dorking, including Westcott.

Roads closed from 07:30:

A24 between Dorking and Leatherhead (including Leatherhead Bypass).
Epsom Road (A246) between West Horsley and Clandon crossroads.

Anticipated road reopening times:

Roads will begin to reopen from 16:30 once it is safe and practical to do so.

LOCAL INFORMATION

All access to and from Westcott by vehicle during the closure period (05:00 to 16:30) must be managed in a safe and co-ordinated manner.

Managed access during the day:

Pre arranged local access along the route between Westcott and Station Road in Dorking can be facilitated until 08:00. All requests must be arranged through our helpdesk prior to the event day.

Access to Westcott during the day will be provided for care workers and other critical non-emergency services through

pre arranged access plans. If you require care provider access or help provide care in Westcott, please contact our helpdesk.

Logmore Lane remains open for the day, but is very narrow with few passing places and can only accommodate very low amounts of traffic. This route is vital for planned access purposes and should only be considered for use by owners of properties adjoining the lane.

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

We will be operating a dedicated Westcott shuttle minibus service on the day for local residents to access local amenities in Dorking. This shuttle service is free. The shuttle will start from the bus stop outside the Westcott House Nursing Home and will stop in Dorking at:

- Dorking train station (20 minutes past the hour)
- Dorking Halls layby (30 minutes past the hour)

The shuttle service will pick up and drop-off at these locations and cater for those with mobility needs. This service will run from 07:00 until 17:00, departing every hour on the hour from Westcott.

Further information

From the Cockerel Roundabout in Dorking, the A25 to the east (Redhill) and the A24 to the south (Horsham) are open all day.

Dorking train station can be accessed by car throughout the day by using Pixham Lane from the A25 and then approaching the train station car park from the north along the A24. Exit from the station car park is only possible southbound.

Please be aware of the wider road closures across the event route in Surrey.

PARKING

Vehicles cannot park on the event route on Sunday 4 August from 00:01. Any vehicle left on the route or parked in a suspended parking bay may be removed. Displaced car parking is available for residents and businesses at the Sports Club from Saturday evening.

EMERGENCY SERVICES

Emergencies will be treated as a priority in the usual way. If you require the emergency services, call 999. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained and prioritised throughout all of the Prudential RideLondon events. Planning for Prudential RideLondon involves the police, fire and rescue

services, ambulance services, local hospitals and other critical welfare services.

ASSISTANCE

The Prudential RideLondon Customer Services team is available if you need assistance both prior to and on the day of the event.

ON THE DAY

Stewards and volunteers will be positioned along the route. If you require assistance on the day that is not a 999 emergency, please ask the event staff who will be able to help or escalate issues if necessary. Alternatively, contact our Customer Services team on 0345 894 9773.

COMMUNITY WELFARE

Prudential RideLondon works with a wide variety of care providers across the entire route in order to plan for the impact of road closures on Sunday 4 August. If you are unsure about care provision on the day or have private arrangements, please contact our Customer Services team so we can help you plan appropriately.

SAFETY

Pedestrian crossing points are located along the event route. These will be supervised to help pedestrians cross the road throughout the event.

Please note that some existing pedestrian crossings may be suspended, but an alternative, where it is easier to cross, will be clearly signed.

We thank you for your patience during the event. Please listen to instructions given by our stewards and volunteers.

Although roads will be closed to general traffic, there will be bicycles and event vehicles using the road during the closure period. Please do take additional care, looking in both directions when crossing the road or accessing and exiting your property, particularly if there is no footway. In certain locations, stewards will be available to assist you.
